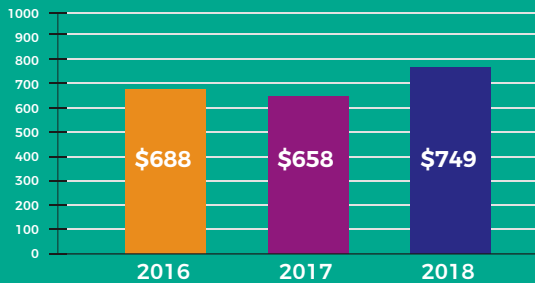


IMPROVED BOARD PERFORMANCE WITH FIRECRACKER

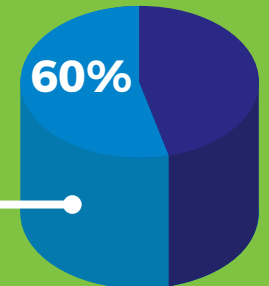


Average spend on resources by medical student has increased over recent years

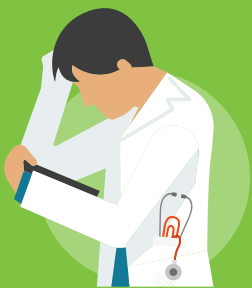

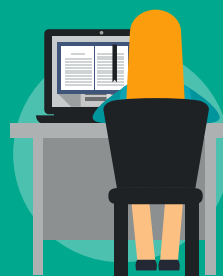

Board review/prep resources continues to account for the bulk of student spend



Medical students spend an average of **55.5 hours** a week studying for the USMLE Step 1 over the course of roughly **20 weeks (19.7)**



During this time students use at least **four (4.4)** online prep resources for USMLE Step 1

37% of students reported using Firecracker as one of those resources



On average, Firecracker users reported higher USMLE Step 1 scores than non-users (**234 vs. 227**) and also higher than the average scores of first-time takers in **2017 (229)**



In fact, Firecracker users were much more likely to **score 250+** than non-users (**25% vs. 8%**).



Firecracker users are also very likely to recommend the product to other students with an **average rating of 8.6** and an **NPS of +42**
